The CEO Update

Nya:weh Sgeno Seneca Nation Citizens,

Building upon the momentum from 2014, Seneca Holdings started off fiscal year 2015 well with a strong first quarter of operations. The subsidiaries of Seneca Holdings – Seneca Telecommunications, LLC, SCMC, LLC and Executive Protection Systems, LLC – are well positioned for a successful 2015. Seneca Telecommunications, SCMC, LLC and Executive Protection Systems are all participants in the Small Business Administration's 8(a) Business Development Program, which will allow each of the subsidiaries to leverage their expertise and professionalism with a unique contracting vehicle.

For 2015, Seneca Holdings is forecasting over \$65 million in consolidated gross revenue. The financial performance of the subsidiaries will be supported by several significant contracts over the course of the year and Seneca Holdings will continue to provide operational efficiencies to assist our subsidiaries. Seneca Holdings expects each of the subsidiaries to contribute to the overall profitability of the organization.

Seneca Telecommunications will build on a successful 2014, which included an operating profit of \$2.4 million. For 2015, Seneca Telecommunications will continue to provide program management and advisory services in support of the Security Cooperation Enterprise Solutions (SCES) Program. The two-year SCES Program award is worth a total of \$19.2 million. Seneca Telecommunications was recently awarded an IDIQ contract to support the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command, which will allow the company to compete in a limited pool of vendors for up to \$650 million in awards over five years. The Cattaraugus Broadband Project will also continue in 2015 and Seneca Telecommunications expects to have the feasible network coverage completed within the next few months.

SCMC, LLC will be focusing on construction and environmental projects in 2015 that bring the best financial return to the company while limiting risk. In addition to wrapping up Phase One on the National Wild Turkey Federation's headquarters in Edgefield, South Carolina, SCMC, LLC will begin work on the Niagara Falls Air Force Base's flight simulator project, continuing work in Fort Drum for the U.S. Army and providing environmental remediation services throughout the Southeast.

Executive Protection Systems is anticipating several federal awards in 2015 as the company continues work on current federal projects, including a Security Operations Center custom design and build out with the Department of Interior, and commercial work. Additionally, EPS is working with the DOI Security Director on several other opportunities to provide safety and security services and the company is also working with the U.S. Census Bureau in preparation for the 2020 Census.

Seneca Holdings and our subsidiaries have established themselves as a well-known and respected brand in the government and commercial marketplace and the hard work of building the proper platform over the past few years is expected to generate opportunities and returns in 2015. As is the case with any successful enterprise, there will be challenges over the course of business for Seneca Holdings and our subsidiaries. The foundation built by our team will allow us to meet the challenges and achieve our objectives while adhering to Seneca Holdings' mission of delivering profitable returns to the Seneca Nation.

We at Seneca Holdings look forward to the opportunities in 2015 and remain focused on providing long-term results for the Seneca Nation. We are grateful for your support as we work to strengthen the economic diversity of the Seneca Nation.

SCMC, LLC TAKES PART IN TOPPING OFF CEREMONY FOR NATIONAL WILD TURKEY FEDERATION PROJECT



Edgefield, SC – As reported last year, SCMC, LLC was awarded a multi-million dollar construction and design project by the National Wild Turkey Federation (NWTF). SCMC was selected through a

full and open competitive bidding process to develop 300 acres for the NWTF's Hunting Heritage & Outdoor Education Center, including the new Palmetto Shooting Complex, at the organization's headquarters in Edgefield, South Carolina. The construction project included two 18 station sporting clay courses, five trap and skeet fields, a pavilion with classroom facilities, and parking and infrastructure to accommodate over 400 vehicles for thousands of visitors to enjoy the entire complex.

On December 8, 2014, SCMC took part in the topping off ceremony for Phase One of the project. The last purlin was set with ceremonial pine bough and flags, including one for the Seneca Nation of Indians. NWTF welcomed over 150 special guests, including board members and representatives from SCMC, for a preview of the new complex and to participate in the ceremonial first shoot. The event was a success as evident by the enthusiasm of the attendees and their appreciation for the quality of work performed by SCMC. The final construction of Phase One is expected to be completed by the end of February 2015.

SENECA TELECOMMUNICATIONS AWARDED 5-YEAR SPAWAR IDIQ CONTRACT



Chantilly, VA – On November 10, 2014, it was announced that Seneca Telecommunications, along with eleven other Federal Contractors, was awarded a large contract in support of the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command or SPAWAR.

SPAWAR develops, delivers and sustains communications and information capabilities for warfighters keeping them connected anytime, anywhere. They execute this mission through geographically dispersed activities, system centers and program offices. Seneca Telecomm will be in direct support of SPAWAR’s Atlantic System Center, located in Charleston, South Carolina.

The contract is a five-year Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Contract with a ceiling of \$650M over the life of the contract. Task orders will be announced and competed amongst the twelve awardees. The initial proposal for this contract was submitted in June, 2014 and Seneca Telecomm was able to put together a team of strong partners in order to secure the win. Although traditionally a purely product focused contract, the statement of work for this award includes the possibility for Services as well. The first task orders are expected to be announced in late January or early February.

As a prime contractor designate on this award, this is a great win for Seneca Telecomm and will provide significant revenue potential over the life of the contract. A list of all twelve awardees is below.
